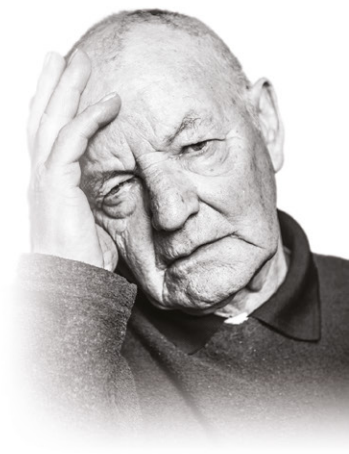




STOP THE SCAMS



What is a SCAM?

Scammers make people give them money or personal information

How do they do it?



They make people feel worried or frighten people



They promise people money and gifts



They promise people services like building and gardening



Scams are done by people who break the law

Different types of SCAMS



Through the post

- You've won a prize
- You can have some money
- Pay first to get goods



Telephone SCAMS

- People call you to try to get your money
- People call to get personal information
- These people pretend to be friendly
- They pretend to be police or from your bank
- They try to make you hurry up



Doorstep SCAMS

- The person tries to get money
- The person tries to get personal information
- They may seem friendly
- The things may be broken
- Too expensive
- Not real
- Done badly



Internet SCAMS

- The website might look real
- Fake emails that look real
- People try to trick you out of your money
