The Dog Control Orders (Prescribed Offences and Penalties, etc.) Regulations 2006 (S.I.2006/1059)

**The Dogs on Leads (Cannock Chase District Council)
Order 2009**

The Cannock Chase District Council hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order comes into force on 1st April 2010
2. This Order applies to the land specified in the Schedule.

Offence

3. (1) A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, at any time, on any land to which this Order applies he does not keep the dog on a lead unless—
 - (a) he has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so; or
 - (b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally specifically) to his failing to do so.
- (2) For the purposes of this article a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

Penalty

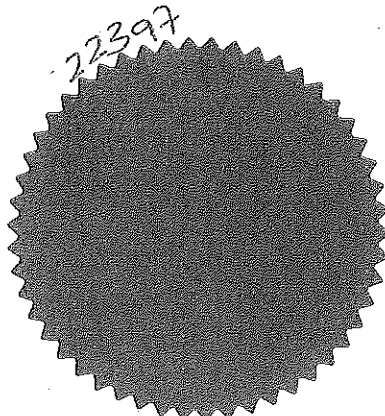
4. A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

SCHEDULE

Specification/description of land, or lands, to which the Order applies

This Order applies to all carriageways and adjoining footpath verges within 3 metres of such carriageways within the District of Cannock Chase. The Order does not apply to land put at the disposal of the Forestry Commissioners under Section 39 of the Forestry Act 1967.
