

4. **Pest Control Service**

Please see attached the Not for Publication Report of the Head of Environmental Health (Item 12.1 – 12.6) which will be considered by Cabinet on 22 September, 2016.

The decision of Cabinet will be circulated to Members as soon as possible after the meeting.

***The decision will need to be implemented very quickly after the Cabinet meeting and the Constitution provides for the call in process to be overridden in cases of urgency.***

***The Political Group Leaders were asked to agree that the decision be exempt from the call-in process. However, no agreement could be reached with the Leaders of the Political Groups for the decision to be exempt from the call-in process. Therefore Paragraph 3.8 of the Scrutiny and Call-in Procedure Rules (Constitution Part 4, Section 31) shall apply. This states that “in the absence of agreement a meeting of the relevant Scrutiny Committee shall be convened as soon as reasonably practicable to consider the matter without the necessity of the call-in procedure being invoked”.***
