6. Mid Staffs NHS Foundation Trust – update

Deborah Neal, Head of Communications, Mid-Staffs NHS Foundation Trust, has provided the following update:

“As the Trust Special Administrators’ (TSAs) consultation is currently underway, the Directors of Mid Staffs have concluded that it would not be appropriate to attend the Community Forums at this time. However if there are any questions on the day to day business of the hospitals, I would be very pleased to provide answers/updates from the Directors.”

7. Question for Staffordshire County Council (Highways)

Question submitted by Mr. P. Gibbs:

With regard to the response to my question regarding speed humps in Wimblebury Road

Q1. How many questionnaires were issued?

Q2. How many were completed / returned?

Q3. How many were in favour of the proposals?

I live in an “adjacent/adjoining” street but did not receive a questionnaire at all, nor anyone I know in the area.

The Community Traffic Management Section has provided the following response:

There were two consultations which took place, firstly letters were sent out to assess the feasibility of a scheme and to gauge if there was sufficient support for the proposal. In which 92 letters were sent to residents, we received 38 responses back of which 29 of these were in favour.

Due to the support as above the official consultation process was sent out of which 124 residents were consulted, 50 responses were received back and 41 of these were in favour of the scheme.

Following the consultation and the positive feedback from the residents, Parish Council, County Councillor and the Emergency Services the public consultation was then launched by way of advertising in the local paper and advertised in the local library. No objections were received. We only send out letters to the residents fronting the proposed scheme, the wider public/residents then have the opportunity to raise any objections at the formal stage via the newspaper adverts.
