6. Proposed Traffic Calming Measures along the High Street in Heath Hayes and Chapel Street

(A) Why are traffic calming measures going to be installed along the High Street in Heath Hayes when there has been a public consultation and presentation on traffic calming options (in Heath Hayes Library) where a majority of those present expressed dissatisfaction with the options presented. The Staffordshire County Council Officer who did the presentation advised that the consultation was intended to gauge public opinion and establish if there was a preferred option from those presented or if the preference was for no works.

(B) Traffic calming in Chapel Street – This is unnecessary when simply enforcing the existing rules in that area, i.e. in respect of parking on double yellow lines and / or half on the pavement at the Post Office end of Chapel Street would be at least as effective and less costly and disruptive.
