 - **There seems to be a large body of evidence in the public domain of the statistics of prior consultation on traffic calming. It appears that on the matter of Hednesford Road only 56 questionnaires were returned of which less than 26 were in favour of any measures.  - **Parking prosecutions given for Chapel Street given as 15 per year. This is unacceptable and reflects the lack of emphasis and endeavour in place by Cannock Chase District Council.**
