DISTRIBUTION OF THE CHAIRMAN'S CHARITY FUND 2005-06

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 To consider the administration and distribution of the Chairman's Charity Fund for the municipal year 2005-06.

2. Recommendation

- 2.1 To approve the distribution of the Chairman's Charity Fund to those organisations outlined in paragraph 4.2.

Section 1

Background

- 3.0 The Chairman of the Council at the beginning of each municipal year, determines which organisations he/she will be supporting during his/her term of office. During this period, the Chairman also receives applications for financial assistance from other organisations.
- 3.1 At the end of his/her term, the Chairman recommends the amount of funds to be distributed to these organisations.

- 4.0 Distribution of the Chairman's Charity Fund 2005-06.
- 4.1 During his term of office as Chairman of the Council, Councillor R.G. Meaden nominated Acorns Children's Hospice and St. Giles Hospice as his charities. A total sum of £6,000 was raised for these and other local organisations.
- 4.2 Set out below are the organisations that Councillor Meaden wishes to benefit from his Charity Fund:-
- Acorns Children's Hospice £3,000
 - St. Giles Hospice £2,000
 - Holly Corien Davies Trust £1,000
