**1. Appointment of Chairman**

Councillor R. Easton was appointed Chairman of the meeting.

**2. Apologies and Reconstitution of Membership**

The Chairman reported that all Members of the Sub-Committee were present and that it was not necessary for a Member to be substituted by another Member taken from the Membership of the full Licensing/Public Protection Committee.

**3. Licensing Act 2003 – Temporary Events Notice – Land at Slitting Mill Road, Rugeley**

It was reported that the applicant had withdrawn the Notice for a Temporary Event.

**4. Premises Licence Application, Pied Piper Public House, 114 Pye Green Road, Cannock**

Consideration was given to the Report of the Head of Environmental Health (Enclosure 5.1 – 5.26 of the Official Minutes of Council).

The representative of the Head of Environmental presented the report. She advised that the application for a Premises Licence for the Pied Piper Public House was considered by the Licensing Sub-Committee on 12 October, 2005. However, one page of the application form was not included within the report and therefore Members did not have the opportunity to consider the matter relating to one licensable activity, the performance of dance.

She explained that Members were being asked to consider an amendment to the Premises Licence granted in respect of the Pied Piper Public House to include the performance of dance as a licensable activity.

She confirmed that the Solicitor who advised Members in October had agreed that the intention was to reduce by one hour all licensable activities but to increase those reduced hours by one hour for Bank Holidays, weekends, Christmas Eve and Boxing Day. The current Solicitor acting for the Pied Piper had confirmed that the applicant was in agreement to the amendment.

RESOLVED:

That the Premises Licence granted in respect of the Pied Piper Public House be amended to include the performance of dance as a licensable activity subject to the same conditions as the other licensable activities previously granted by the Licensing Sub-Committee on 12 October, 2005.
