Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

APPLYING TO ALCOHOL SALES

1) No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence;

(a) at a time when there is no Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of this premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a personal licence, or his/her personal licence is suspended.

2) Every supply of alcohol under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

3) (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

GENERAL

NOTHING BEYOND EXISTING HEALTH & SAFETY / FIRE SAFETY ETC. REQUIREMENTS.

PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

ALSO LOCK UP PREMISES WILL HAVE INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL CCTV RECORDINGS OF WHICH WILL BE RETAINED FOR THIRTY ONE DAYS. THERE ARE EXISTING EXTERNAL, FRONTAGE ROLLER SHUTTERS AND THE PREMISES WILL BE FULLY ALARMED, INCLUDING A PANIC BUTTON FACILITY. THE LICENCE HOLDER SHALL ENSURE THAT ANY STAFF INVOLVED IN THE SALE OF ALCOHOL ARE FULLY AWARE OF THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003M VIA 'IN HOUSE' RECORDED TRAINING, FROM A CURRENT ACCREDITED LICENSING MANUAL.

PUBLIC SAFETY

ALSO INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL CCTV ETC.
PREMISES WILL HAVE FULLY MAINTAINED FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT ON SITE WITH A MAINTENANCE CONTRACT ALONG WITH EMERGENCY LIGHTING AND SMOKE DETECTORS.

PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

ALSO INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL CCTV IN PARTICULAR, WILL ACT AS A DETERRENT TO ANY ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOR OR GATHERINGS IN THE IMMEDIATE FRONTAGE OF THE PREMISES.

THE APPLICANT WILL ENSURE THAT HIS DESIGNATED PREMISES SUPERVISOR AND HIS STAFF WILL BE VIGILANT IN TERMS OF LITTER CONTROL WITHIN THE VICINITY OF THEIR RETAIL OUTLET.

PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM

INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL CCTV ETC.
LAYOUT OF SHOP GIVES CONSIDERATION TO THE PREVENTION OF CHILDREN'S ACCESS TO ALCOHOL AND ANY ALCOHOL DISPLAYED WILL NOT BE OBSTRUCTED FROM THE VIEW OF THE SALES ASSISTANTS. ALSO PREMISES WILL OPERATE A CONDITION REPLACED ON 12 JANUARY 2010 IN AGREEMENT WITH THE POLICE A SALES REFUSAL BOOK WILL BE FULLY MAINTAINED.

THE FOLLOWING CONDITION, WHICH IS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE, WAS AGREED BETWEEN THE LICENCE HOLDER AND STAFFORDSHIRE POLICE ON 12 JANUARY 2010.

IF A PERSON APPEARS TO BE UNDER THE AGE OF 25 THEY WILL BE CHALLENGED FOR IDENTIFICATION TO PROVE THEY ARE OVER 18 YEARS OF AGE. THE ONLY FORMS OF ID TO BE ACCEPTED WILL BE A PASSPORT, A PHOTO DRIVING LICENCE OR A PROOF OF AGE CARD THAT HAS THE PASS ACCREDITATION HOLOGRAM ON IT.
