I am in receipt of an application by Trading Standards for the review of a premise licence at Bazda Booze and Convenience Store, 8 Queensway, Rugeley, Staffordshire, WS15 1NN. Police wish to make representations in support of this application on the grounds of Prevention of Crime and Disorder and the Protection of Children from Harm.

The premise has had two positive sales of alcohol to children within a three year period and clearly despite intervention and a previous review hearing where the licence was suspended the premise licence holder/Designated Premise Supervisor have still failed in their obligations to uphold the objectives of the Act and the Law.

We are in full support of Trading Standards with their request of revocation of the licence.
