

*established cover and public transport Bradbury Lane*





There are multiple advantages:

In-line with surrounding community amenities

No requirement for security perimeter fencing

Impact to local residents minimised by existing trees and hedgerows, low land position such as noise and light

Additional traffic is negligible, larger car park area

Public transport route, more central to Hednesford

Few minutes walk to Cannock Chase

More freedom to capitalise on business opportunities - multiple use and private hire

Maximise use of building without compromises

Retention of immediate green space bordering building keeping harmonious balance with wildlife instead of complete loss

Lighting scheme absorbed and in-line with surrounding amenities and less consequential to residents

Large space allows projects; gardening, composting, grass roots Scout activities - trees are not SSI, camping, water features, composting toilets, larger activity space

Development of protected green space cushioned by another even larger adjacent green space
