Emergency Aid is a registered charitable organisation who specialise in 24/7 instant access Secure Covert Rest Centres (SCRCs) for use in the event of a terrorist attack as well as offering surge overflow capacity for existing civil provision, antiviral distribution centres in a pandemic and workplace disaster sites for government organisations in anonymous empty office buildings.

There are various emergency uses which these premises may be used for, such as a Secure Rest Centre in the event of a terrorist attack, a back-up ambulance station, as disaster recovery for Government organisations, Local Authorities and Category 1 Responders.

To facilitate their role as a disaster recovery centre, the premises at Beecroft Court, Beecroft Road, Cannock are used to carry out quarterly deployment trials which last for 2 days; this will include the setting out of beds, table and chairs.
