
How are we doing so far?

We said we would: Increase the reuse and recycling of waste

By:

Undertake an information & motivational campaign to reduce residual waste and increase recycling:

Campaign started in Quarter 1 with the distribution of 41,500 'TRIM YOUR BIN' waste and recycling calendar and information booklets.





As performance measures:

Residual household waste per household: Annual target=550kgs:

Qtr 2 figures confirmed by SCC at 107kg/HH.

Qtr 3 figures estimated at 92kg prior to confirmation from SCC.



% of Household waste sent for re-use, recycling and composting:

Qtr 2 figures confirmed at 54% by SCC.

Qtr 3 figures estimated at 53% prior to confirmation by SCC.



We said we would: Work with partners to reduce the impact and perceptions of anti-social behaviour

By:

Undertake 2 Stop and Search exercises with Staffordshire Police to determine correct documentation on the carrying of waste 3 Stop and Searches were undertaken during Quarter 3 with the assistance of Staffordshire Police.



Contacting all local companies that handle the two main waste streams which are predominantly flytipped in the District and randomly sample 20% of them to provide documentation to confirm their compliance with Duty of Care.



All actions will be undertaken during Quarter 4 due to staff relocation and availability on 6 industrial estates during the first Quarter.

Ensuring all abandoned vehicles are removed within 24 hours of notification.

4 vehicles were inspected within 24 hrs of receiving a report, none of which were considered abandoned therefore none were removed in this period.
