In accordance with Rules 12 ('Procedure Before Taking Key Decisions') and 14 ('General Exception') of the Council's Access to Information Procedure Rules, the above item which was not included on the Forward Plan of Decisions for April – June, 2019, is notified as not having been included on the Plan for the following reasons:

“The Managing Director met with a representative from the charity ‘Beat the Cold’ week commencing 25 March 2019, who advised that because the Council had not signed up to a Statement of Intent, eligible households were not receiving all external funds linked to fuel efficiency funds etc., and most other district / borough councils had signed up to these schemes. There are no financial implications for the Council and the scheme is largely managed by ‘Beat the Cold’. There is an urgency as the next Cabinet meeting is not until June 2019, and it would mean that funding opportunities would be lost on these matters.”

Accordingly, it was impracticable to include the above item on the Plan.
