I, Fiona Ledden being the Police Area Returning Officer for the above election, do hereby give notice that the number of votes recorded for each candidate is as follows:

| *ELLIS Matthew Clyde | The Conservative Party Candidate | 63,123 | 11,877 | 75,000 |

**As the candidate polling the most votes in the First Preference Count received an overall majority of the First Preference votes, under Rule 59 (5) (a) of Schedule 3 of the Police and Crime Commissioner Elections Order 2012, there was no requirement to count the Second Preference Votes.
