Community Infrastructure Levy [CIL] Annual Financial Report [2020/21] to be published by 31 December 2021

Cannock Chase Council [CCDC – the Charging Authority] introduced a CIL charging schedule on the 1st June 2015. Regulation 62A of the Community Infrastructure Regulations 2010 [as amended] [CIL Regulations] requires the Town/Parish Council to produce an annual report for each financial year setting out the amount of CIL receipts received; spending of CIL receipts; and the amount of CIL retained by the Council for future spend. This report covers the period from 1st April 2020 – 31st March 2021.
