**6. Minutes**

RESOLVED:

That the Minutes of the meeting held on 28 June 2007 be approved as a correct record.

**7. Update on Chairman's Charity Ball**

Mike Worsnop, Leisure Operations Manager provided Members with an update on the Chairman's Charity Ball. He explained that the Ball would be held on 15 March 2008 with a swing 'n' 60's theme. The Tremeloes had been booked to provide the entertainment along with the "Swingin' Jims Dance Band" who had played at the Civic Sunday event. Members were shown the proposed poster and table decoration which both had a 60's theme. The proposed flyer, which included a booking form, was in the shape of the cover of a 45 single and was circulated for Members information. It was explained that following last year's success, it was anticipated that approximately 400 tickets would be sold for the event. The tickets were priced at £40 each and would be going on sale on 1 November 2007. He stated that the Chairman's chosen charities were BDF Newlife, British Skin Foundation and Birmingham Children's Hospital and the tickets would emphasise the charities which were being supported. It was anticipated that there would be a signed England Rugby shirt and ball available to auction on the evening.

**8. Civic Gifts**

The Chairman's Secretary explained that quotes had been obtained for an embroidered badge of the Council's coat of arms which was suitable to be worn on both male and female jackets. For an order of 1-10 badges the price would be £24.99 each and for an order of 31-50 badges the price would be £22.99 each.

It was suggested that Members and Officers should be contacted to ascertain whether there would be enough interest in the product to warrant placing an order with the supplier. A colour photograph of the product should be included within the correspondence.
