



Community Safety Delivery Plan 2017/20

(2019/20 Update)

Introduction

Community Safety Partnerships (CSPs) are statutorily responsible for reducing crime and disorder, substance misuse and re-offending in their local authority area. The local Strategic Assessment, produced by the Strategy Team at Staffordshire County Council and the Research and Analysis Unit at Staffordshire Police, informs the CSP of its priorities, whilst the Community Safety Delivery Plan sets out what the CSP is doing to address these issues.

The specific Strategic Priorities for Cannock Chase’s CSP for 2019/20 are:

- **Domestic Abuse – develop awareness of potential indicators of risk amongst those in face-to-face roles within public-facing services;**
- **Anti-social Behaviour – improve knowledge of the scale of ASB in the District, leading to a greater understanding of localities and victims;**
- **Drugs (supply and possession) – continued and increased education and awareness around drugs;**
- **Missing Children – ensure a multi-agency approach is maintained to support persons who are presenting repeated missing episodes; with a cross-cutting theme of:**
- **Vulnerability – ensure a co-ordinated approach is maintained with the emphasis on early intervention and prevention.**

In addition to the above, Cannock Chase’s CSP operates under the umbrella of the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner for Staffordshire’s (PFCC) Community Safety Priorities. These are:

- Early Intervention – tackling the root causes before they become a problem;
- Supporting Victims and Witnesses – making it easier for victims and witnesses to get the support they need locally;
- Managing Offenders – preventing offending in the first place and reducing the likelihood of re-offending;
- Increasing Public Confidence – making sure everything that happens in partnership contributes to individuals and communities feeling safer and reassured.
