Supporting Information:

Connexions Staffordshire Ltd is a 'Non-Profit' making company set-up to provide information, advice and guidance services for the young people of Stoke-on-Trent and Staffordshire. The company is entirely public funded, principally through the DfES Grant in order to provide the Connexions Service to the county.

Access to the companies services are freely available to ALL 13-19 year olds (up to 24 years of age if having learning difficulties) under the Connexions contract to all those referred to them by other agencies, for example Jobcentres. In particular the company targets 'harder to help' clients from disadvantaged sections of the community. Clients with additional needs such as teenage mums are a particular focus.

Information, advice and guidance is provided to all clients including training in basic skills, CV writing, interview techniques to those that have need of it. Connexions Staffordshire work closely with Local Authorities to enhance and supplement their work; services are also provided under a statutory duty, which would otherwise fall on Authorities.

Staffordshire Connexions Ltd are members of the National Association of Connexions Partnerships (NACP) and exist by reason of statute – they are obliged to provide their services to all residents of the Staffordshire sub-region.

Comments:

Staffordshire Connexions Ltd have achieved registration as a charity with effect from 12 December 2007. The organisation was previously in receipt of 50% discretionary relief, however, due to their change of status they now qualify for 80% mandatory relief and now wish to be considered for additional top up discretionary relief - the recommendation in this report is for 10% discretionary relief which is in line with other similar organisations within this Authorities area.
