1. Minutes

RESOLVED:

That the Minutes of the meeting held on 9 August 2006 be approved as a correct record.

2. Use of Charity Owned Land for Election Purposes

Consideration was given to a report of the Director of Governance (Enclosure 4.1 – 4.2)

Following consideration of the report, the Trustees requested that investigations be undertaken into the suitability of using the existing Pavilion at Cannock Park for the purposes

of administering and discharging election functions. In the event of the Pavilion not being suitable, the Trustees agreed to the use of a temporary structure on the land identified in the report.

RESOLVED:

- (A) That investigations be undertaken into the suitability of using the Pavilion at Cannock Park for the purposes of administering and discharging election functions.
- (B) That in the event of the Pavilion not being suitable:
 - (i) Cannock Chase District Council be granted a licence at will for the purpose of using the area cross-hatched on Appendix 1 of the report for the purposes of providing a temporary location for the administration and discharge of election functions.
 - (ii) That such a licence be granted whenever the Council is required to administer an election / referendum.
 - (iii) That the land be available to the Council for the locating of a temporary structure for up to 10 days.
 - (iv) That the gates to Cannock Park on the election day itself be open from 6.00am until 10.30pm.
