**NOTICE OF PROPOSED POST SUBMISSION MAIN
MODIFICATIONS TO CANNOCK CHASE LOCAL PLAN (PART1)
November 2013**

Cannock Chase Local Plan (Part 1) sets out the strategic and development management policy for the District up to 2028 to help shape the way in which its physical, economic, social and environmental characteristics will change. It brings together the former emerging Core Strategy and Rugeley Town Centre Area Action Plan into one document. It is a Development Plan Document produced under the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, as amended.

Following Publication of the Local Plan (Part 1) representations were invited and made and the documents and information were submitted to the Secretary of State for independent examination on 31st May 2013. As part of the examination hearings held on 24 to 27 September 2013 issues of legal compliance and 'soundness' were identified. Post Submission Modifications are now proposed to address these issues and this consultation provides those with an interest in Local Plan (Part 1) to make representations, stating whether the proposed Main Modifications address these matters of legal compliance and 'soundness' by **5:00pm on Wednesday 18 December 2013**. The representations will be considered by the Planning Inspector conducting the examination.
