3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 6th May, 2021.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday, 19 April, 2021. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote> .
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Beecroft Road, Cannock, Staffordshire, WS11 1BG by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, 20th April, 2021.
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Beecroft Road, Cannock, Staffordshire, WS11 1BG by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, 27th April, 2021.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Centre, Beecroft Road, Cannock, Staffordshire, WS11 1BG by 5 pm on Thursday, 6th May, 2021. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Tuesday, 27th April, 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 p.m. on Tuesday, 27th April, 2021.
