Cannock Wood Neighbourhood Plan Consultation (Local Authority Publicity Period under Regulation 16, Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations, 2012)

I refer to your email of the 3 July 2023 in relation to the above Neighbourhood Plan (NP) consultation. We have reviewed the document but, in the absence of specific sites allocated within areas of fluvial flooding, wound not offer a bespoke comment at this time.

Based on our indicative Flood Map for Planning, the Parish area lies within Flood Zone 1, the low-risk Zone. However, it should be noted that the Flood Map for Planning provides an indication of 'fluvial' flood risk only. You are advised to discuss matters relating to surface water (pluvial) flooding with your drainage team as the Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA).
