



- To pick litter (4)


4) What is good about going out to play?




5a) Please explain other




7) If you answered no, do you have any other suggestions for a theme?

There were 21 responses to this question. Themes varied with the most popular being:


- Money better spent on safe equipment (2)

There were 61 responses to this question, with a variety of comments. The most common themes were:


- This is a long overdue revamp (9)
